Vision and Reading Checklist

- Short attention span for reading
- Words run together when reading
- Must read and re-read material to understand it well
- Skips words or loss of place when reading
- Confuses similar words
- Takes “hours” to do homework that should take a few minutes
- Reversals of letters/words
- Poor attention to reading and writing tasks
- Eye fatigue or strain
- Rubs eyes, red eyes or gets headaches in the afternoon
